1979 - 1984

Sporadically raced in different events. Mostly national and european hillclimb racing. Last race at Schauinsland.

1984

Sold to Mr. Kauhs, the owner of Rosso Bianco Museum, and restored by Matter for exhibition at his museum.

2014 - 2015

Brought to race ready condition while maintaining the original condition that was preserved over the years in the museum. Raced by Brunn family in Classic Endurance Racing. 3rd overall in P2 at Paul Ricard in 2015.

The TOJ SC206 was one of the most advanced Group 6 racing car in period. It is an ideal car to race in the P2 class of the Classic Endurance Racing series and also listed as an eligible type of car for Le Mans Classic.
